



CALL FOR ANNUAL NASW STUDENT NOMINATIONS

The NASW MS Chapter's annual program meeting is being held March 24-25, 2022, at the Hilton Hotel, Jackson, MS. One of the most important parts of this program is the opportunity to recognize some of our future leaders in social work. To achieve this goal, we are asking that each school submit the name of **one** (1) outstanding bachelor's level and **one** (1) master's level student for recognition as the school's top student(s). Only one student's name from each separate CSWE accredited social work program can be submitted. Each nominated student will be recognized with an award at the Annual Conference and Gala. From the school's nominations, one outstanding bachelor level and one outstanding master's level student will be recognized. These students will be awarded with a monetary gift from the National Association of Social Workers-Mississippi Chapter.

Enclosed are the guidelines for nominations. Each faculty representative must submit a summary as outlined in the guidelines. The school's designated representative will complete the enclosed form, summary of qualifications, and letters of recommendation. These documents should be submitted to the Chapter office by **February 18, 2022**. Note that the enclosed form must be signed by the school's Director/Chair or Dean.

Also enclosed are criteria for nomination for other awards recognized at the conference. Please share these with your colleagues and encourage nominations in these additional areas. These nominations are to also be submitted to the Chapter office by February 18, 2022 at conference.naswms@socialworkers.org.
